Why Sell Bee Friendly Bulbs?

Bulbs farmed using insecticides store this poison in the heart of the bulb. When it comes to flower the next spring, the sap that rises brings with it this poison.

Each time the bee visits the flower, looking for that early source of nectar and pollen, they get a dose of the toxin which leaves them disorientated and weak.



How to Stop The Poisoning

The answer to this is simple - plant organic bulbs!

You not only help the bees, but know the land they are grown on is being treated with respect too.

How Do Bulbs Improve My Garden?

You plant bulbs in the autumn, but it is easy to forget during the dark days of winter that outside the bulbs are working hard putting roots into the ground, preparing to fulfil their potential and burst into life as the weather warms in spring.

It is like having a beautifully gift-wrapped present sat in the cupboard, which you can touch, even gently shake to try and discover what it is, but you are not allowed to open just yet....

Tips for Choosing and Planting Your Bee Friendly Bulbs

Add a '0' to however many you think you need - 100 is better than 10 for making an amazing display (and 1000 will transform your garden...!)

Choose fewer varieties for greater effect - a scented variety for pots on the patio or by the entrance to the house, then a wilder, simpler flowered variety for naturalising in grass or amongst shrubs.

Add a new variety each year to build your collection.

Plant the bulb to twice its own depth.

Get daffodils in the ground in September or October, tulips in November.
